

Industry launches information portal for compressed air

Industry and the public can now access up-to-date information on compressed air technology, suppliers, and quality standards through a new website launched last month. The website is hosted by the industry as a means of ensuring safety and quality in all compressed air applications.

Compressed Air Australasia spokesperson, Julia Beck, said the service was a key step towards achieving the industry's goal of universal adoption of reliable compressor standards. "Compressed air is a complex and potentially confusing field, with customers often unsure of what information is reliable and what is sales spin," Ms Beck said. "This website will ensure industry and the

general public can get reliable answers from a trustworthy source."

The new approach is being promoted by the Compressed Air Association of Australasia, together with its updated Protocol 2000+. This performance standard is a crucial part of the industry's campaign to establish Free Air Delivery (or FAD) as the most accurate performance basis for all compressor units.

"When measured according to Protocol 2000+, FAD is the only certain means of nominating the actual and effective output of a compressor," Ms Beck said.
